Giving is not just about donating your money. It is about making a difference. Every week SHSAA receives gifts from alumni who want to honor or memorialize someone special in their lives or in other cases to recognize their high school class.

Generous donations that are so thoughtfully given are added to the balance of monies invested and ultimately awarded to SHS students in the form of academic and vocational scholarships. Conversely, the named scholarships, established by a \$100,000 donation, are categorized differently. These awarded scholarships are given out to students with specific criteria per the wishes of the donor and set by the scholarship committee.

The Building for the Future campaign monies were donor-directed with the same caring designations but were earmarked strictly for the renovation costs. 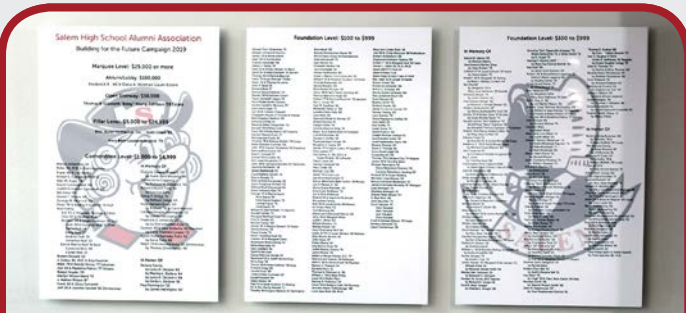

Betsy Johnson's Bequest Devoted to Renovation

The open staircase in the renovated atrium at the Salem High School Alumni Association is named in honor of Elizabeth "Betsy" Young Johnson '59 and her husband Thomas B. Johnson, D.D.S.

Betsy served on SHSAA's board from 1970 to 1998 and was secretary of the scholarship committee for several years.

"My mother was involved in a number of organizations in the Salem community, and she viewed the alumni association as one of the most important. She always felt that academic scholarship is an important foundation," Mark T. Johnson '83, M.D., Ph.D., explained in a phone interview.

Mark is the eldest of the Johnsons' children. He and his siblings Sarah Johnson '87 and Daniel B. Johnson '91 shared memories of their parents during a phone conference call in December. Mark spoke from Santa Monica, CA, where he is the medical director at NantOmics, a cancer diagnostics laboratory, and is founder of RepGenTech, an early stage reproductive genetic diagnostics company. Sarah spoke from Pittsburgh, PA where she is an active member of the Shadyside Presbyterian Church and is involved with a number of charitable organizations; and Daniel spoke from Boston, MA, where he is a poet and director of Mass Poetry, a nonprofit organization promoting the creation, dissemination, and appreciation of poetry.

Betsy included SHSAA in her will as one of her largest beneficiaries. Her generous \$50,000 bequest arrived at the office in June.

In response to the association's Building for the Future fundraising campaign, the Johnson siblings asked that the association board devote their mother's entire gift toward the renovation. They selected the open stairway from among the items the association had identified for naming rights.



The stairway plaque honors both Betsy and Tom, who celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary in 2014, for their philanthropy and their special marriage bond.

"Inseparable in sickness and in health" is how the Johnson siblings described their parents' relationship in Betsy's obituary. Betsy died July 29, 2018. Tom died April 1, 2015.

The close-knit home life they created in their Southeast Boulevard home in Salem was tragically tested in 1997 when Betsy was diagnosed with a degenerative disease. She spent more than 20 years in long-term care facilities with Tom as her faithful, daily visitor. In the 10 years following his retirement, Tom visited his beloved Betsy twice a day to help her with meals.

"He was an exemplary role model," Mark said.

Building a Lifetime Partnership

Betsy and Tom's romance began when they were students at Denison University in Granville, OH.

Tom was from Jamestown, NY, the largest town near Lake Chautauqua. "They met in college, and they then really built their relationship one summer when my mom was working at the Athenaeum Hotel at the Chautauqua Institution. My father, who spent his summer at a cottage on the lake, courted her by boat," Mark said. Tom's parents were Merle and Althea Johnson. His dad had a plumbing business.

Betsy was one of the first female Denison graduates to earn an economics degree, and she worked at Euclid Bank in Cleveland after graduating. Tom's bachelor's degree was in biology.

They wed on June 21, 1964, in the rose gardens of the Highland Avenue home of her parents, William Eugene Young and Virginia McKee Young. Her father owned Young & Merrill Insurance.

Tom completed his dental surgery degree from The State University of New York at Buffalo in 1966. He then served two years in the U.S.

Army Reserves as a dentist and commissioned officer at Fort Carson, CO. Mark was born while they were stationed in Colorado.

From Colorado they moved back to Salem, Betsy's hometown, where Sarah and Daniel were born. Tom set up his dental practice in a red frame house at 131 South Lincoln Avenue and cared for many patients for the next 37 years. He was proud that Salem News readers selected him as "Best Dentist in Salem" one year.

Volunteering with Energy & Enthusiasm

"My mom had an incredible community network in Salem. She was following in the footsteps of her parents and grandparents, who had been very active in the community. It was fantastic to have so many people that we knew as family friends. Our house was a drawing point for the whole Southeast Boulevard community. All the kids would come over to our house, even when we weren't around," Mark said.

Sarah describes her mom as an extrovert and extremely kind person. "She was so involved in the First Presbyterian church; she was a Sunday school teacher. She just felt like the church was really important in establishing values. She was just like a total encourager. She was kind of like a Nehemiah from the Bible or a Barnabas—just always building people up rather than tearing them down."

Betsy was selected as "Most Friendly" by her classmates for the honors included in the 1959 Quaker.

Gail "Bud" Herron '62, who served with Betsy on the alumni association board for many years, remembers her being a "real contributor" to it and other Salem organizations. For instance, when Herron began organizing an SHS alumni band for the

jubilee parades, he said, "Betsy did all the work." She contacted former band members to ask them to play and raised money to buy the matching shirts the musicians wore. "She was just so helpful on everything," he said.

Blending Academic Goals & Fun

Betsy's joie de vivre also meant she rode the biggest roller coasters with the kids at Cedar Point and enjoyed water skiing. Some of the Johnson siblings' favorite memories include quiet times at home, trips to their grandparents' Lake Chautauqua cottage, and vacations at East Coast beaches, Toronto, and the Rocky Mountains.

When their Dad returned home from work each day, their parents would retreat to the living room to chat. "My mother was so happy to have him home and the two of them would go to our living room and he would talk about the day ... A lot of it was not overtly stated, but you could tell that they really cared about each other," Mark said.

"Oftentimes they would split a beer," Daniel added.

He remembered the house being filled with books and both parents emphasizing hard work in school. They set college degrees as a goal for all of them.

"They really emphasized education. They gave us a chance to travel and learn ... Those were their top priorities in life," Daniel said.

Mark recalled his mom telling him about what SHSAA scholarship winners were planning to do in college, as a way of challenging him.

Sarah remembered her mom making a special trip to see her at college when she was stressed about writing a particular paper. "That meant a great deal to me. I'll never forget that," she said.

"Strive to be your best self. Be authentic," were among the words of advice Sarah remembers her mom sharing. "I studied at the University of East Anglia. It's in Norwich, England. She encouraged me to apply to that program, and I did, and was accepted. That was so enriching. It really opened my eyes to different cultures. My brother Mark studied at King's College in London, which inspired me," Sarah said.

Betsy was also willing to bend the rules, as Daniel explains, recounting an unusual high school experience.

"I was studying for one of Mr. Turner's chemistry tests, and friends were going to see the Rolling Stones at Cleveland Municipal Stadium. Somehow I made the case to Mom that she should let me go, and I went ... and I ended up doing really well on the test. I think one of the lessons of that was you can have fun. You can be serious, and you can lead a life outside your academics."

And, he speculated, that if faced with a similar opportunity in her youth "Mom, not Dad, would have been the one at the Rolling Stones concert."

The Johnson siblings recently saw a picture of the plaque commemorating their parents' contribution that has been placed at the foot of the staircase and gave their enthusiastic endorsement.

They commented via email that given their parents' love and commitment to the town and its downtown area, it is fitting to have them warmly smiling to staff and visitors to the office. "We hope many others will follow their example and continue to make Salem the special place that it has been for our family for many generations."

As a retired music educator, Tom realizes the important value of home and family and often comments that there is not another town in America that can hold a candle to Salem when it comes to nurturing and growing young people!

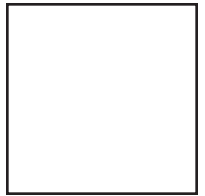
